


## Greetings La Cima Families/Caregivers,

Thank you for your attendance and participation in our recent Town Hall on August 9<sup>th</sup>! As a follow up to that conversation, I would like to outline the new uniform expectations so that you have absolute clarity.

- La Cima is a uniform school. Standardizing the expectations for dress ensure focus remains on our primary goal of teaching and learning at high levels and not on who has the trendiest outfit.
- As such, **all** scholars are expected to wear the La Cima uniform **every day** without exception.
- If circumstances are such that you are not able to send your scholar to school in full uniform, please be sure to send a note or call the school as soon as possible. We will do our best to make appropriate accommodations. Please see the charting below which reflects the dress code by grade level:







- As shared during the meeting, we will be providing ALL La Cima families with three short-sleeved polos; a La Cima backpack and lunchbox.
- As per our family and student handbook, variations in the school uniform are not permitted. Students who arrive at school out of uniform will receive a phone call home so that someone may bring the correct uniform or we will loan a uniform to the scholar for the day.
- Be sure to label ALL of your scholars clothing so that lost items may easily be identified and returned to you.
- We know that a shift like this takes time to adjust to. Until you are able to purchase the new uniform; scholars are allowed to wear the old La Cima uniform. New scholars may wear a white polo and navy bottoms.
- All scholars are expected to be in full uniform by October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

We are very excited about this change and look forward to seeing our scholars in their radiant blue.
